This order shall dispose of COCP Nos. 4811, 4836 to 4840 and 5065 to 5069 of 2018, as common issue is involved in all these petitions.

Reply dated 28.11.2019 by way of short affidavit of Mr. Sukhjeet Pal Singh, Director, Public Instructions (S.E.), Punjab (Mohali) filed in Court is taken on record, copy handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the State relying upon the pleadings of the affidavit and instructions from Mr. Nilesh Sharma, Senior Assistant, O/o DPI (S.E.), Punjab submits that the judgment of this Court would be implemented subject to the outcome of the pending litigation in the Apex Court. He further submits that there are certain verifications and other

procedural barriers to be crossed and the needful would be done within two

months from today.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that there are certain errors with regard to the particulars of some of the petitioners.

In order to resolve the said issue, let the petitioner move a representation within one week from today, in case that is done, the respondents shall look into the representation and pass a speaking order within three weeks after receipt of the representation.
