The petitioner has participated for the post of PGT (Political Science) under the general category. As per the final result dated 15.11.2018, the last selected candidate under the general category has secured 129 marks.

Learned counsel for the State has produced the final result of the petitioner in Court today. The petitioner has secured 114 marks in the written examination, 04 marks in experience and 14 marks in the viva voce. Total marks are 132. The marks of the petitioner are higher than the last selected candidate under the general category. Result of the petitioner has been returned to learned counsel for the State.

In the present case, the petitioner is seeking benefit of the judgment passed by this Court in *CWP-2129-2017 Rakesh Kumar and another V/s. State of Haryana and others decided on 02.05.2017* (Annexure P-4) wherein it has been held that the validity of all the STET certificate was upto 20.07.2016.

Learned counsel for the State is not disputing that the aforesaid judgment has not attained finality and no LPA has been filed against this judgment.

This petition is being disposed of by giving direction to the respondent to recommend the case of the petitioner for appointment after verifying her STET certificate keeping in view the aforesaid judgment (Annexure P-4) within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
