Present petition is for under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.224 dated 03.06.2018 under Sections 304 (II) of IPC, registered at Police Station Patuadi, District Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that initially the case under Section 304-A IPC was registered on the basis of statement of the complainant as it was a case of road accident having taken place with car. Thereafter, on the basis of supplementary statement of the son of the deceased recorded on 25.08.2018, police has completed the investigation and submitted report under Section 304(II) IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further contended that the

run over the car, whereas it was a case of vehicular accident only. More so, the petitioner was admitted to interim bail on 06.12.2018 till today and he has not misused the concession of bail.

Learned State counsel while opposing the bail application contended that it was a case under Section 304(II) of IPC, as per investigation, so, he does not deserve the concession of bail.

Having considered the submission made by learned counsel for the parties and the fact that initially it was a case of vehicular accident only and the present petitioner was ordered to be released on interim to bail; the trial of the case still to take some more time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bar any more, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be admitted on regular bail on furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of concerned learned trial Judge/ Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate.
