The prayer of the petitioner in the present writ petition is that unfortunately, the wife of the petitioner, who was serving on regular basis as JBT Teacher, died on 12.10.2018 but after her death, the benefits for which the petitioner and his minor children became entitle under the Haryana Compassionate Assistance to the Dependents of Deceased Govt. Employees Rules, 2006, have not been released. The prayer of the petitioner is for issuance of a direction to respondent No. 2 to decide his claim, which has been duly forwarded by the Principal to whom, a representation (date has not been mentioned in the said representation) (Annexure P-4) was submitted by the petitioner alongwith an affidavit, in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on

the merits of the case and the claim being made by the petitioner, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 to consider the claim of the petitioner and the minor children of deceased Smt. Sonika for the release of the benefits under the Haryana Compassionate Assistance to the Dependents of Deceased Govt. Employees Rules, 2006 by passing an appropriate speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case, the minors are found to eligible for the grant of said benefit, the same shall be released to them within a period of one months of the passing of the said order.

Writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
