AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

In pursuance to the order passed by this Court on 13.12.2020, counsel for the State has, on the basis of the records made available to him and on instructions from Shri Parveen Kumar Kadyan, Assistant Registrar Cooperative Societies, Jind – respondent No.4, submitted that no objections were received from the petitioner within the period as has been specified in the communication/letter dated 05.08.2019 (Annexure P-2), meaning thereby, no objections were received from the petitioner between 02.08.2019 till 22.08.2019. Further, on 26.08.2019 also, the petitioner did not turn up for hearing. Had there been any objection filed by him, he would have come present for hearing/pressing his objections, which he has not done. On the said date, 23 objections were heard and decision taken thereon.

He, on the basis of these records, submitted that the averments made by the petitioner in the writ petition are false as no document has been placed on record in support of the averments nor has any specific date mentioned in the application as to when the objections were submitted by the petitioners. It has further been stated that in pursuance to the communication which was received from the office of the Chief Minister on the complaint, which has been submitted by the petitioner, the same has also been considered and decided by the Deputy Registrar Cooperative Societies, Rohtak, on 18.12.2019. The said objections have been rejected on the ground that they did not have any force.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has produced a letter/objection dated 01.08.2019 submitted to the Chairman, Zonal Committee, The Jind District Cooperative Labour & Construction Federation Limited, Jind, to which, counsel for the State has rightly pointed out that the objections, in any case, could not have been submitted by the petitioner on the said date as the objections were called for as per the communication dated 05.08.2019 (Annexure P-2), which is subsequent to the alleged date of submission of objections.

In the light of the above, no merit is found in the present writ petition, the same stands dismissed.
