Learned State counsel submits that out of total seventeen prosecution witnesses, ten witnesses have been examined; five witnesses have been given up and the next date fixed before the trial Court is 15.02.2019 for examination of remaining two witnesses. The petitioner is the main accused and because of injury inflicted by him, the death has occurred.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail on the ground that his co-accused has been released on bail.

Keeping in view the role attributed to the petitioner viz-a-viz co-accused, no parity can be claimed.

Accordingly, by considering the stage of trial as all the prosecution witnesses have been examined except two witnesses, no ground is made out to release the petitioner on regular bail.

Learned counsel for the petitioner wants to withdraw this petition.
