1. Prayer in the writ petition is for the issuance of a writ of Mandamus for directing the respondents to regularize the service of the petitioners in term of government instructions Annexure P/3 dated 01.10.2003, w.e.f. from the date respondent Nos.4 and 5 i.e. juniors to the petitioners were regularized and to grant all consequential benefits.

2. Learned counsel contends that the petitioners were appointed as daily paid worker on 18.11.1997, on the post of water carrier and sweeper, against a permanent post and that although respondent Nos.4 and 5 juniors to the petitioners have been regularized by respondent Nos.1 to 3, but the claim of the petitioners for regularization has not been considered and decided till date despite legal notice Annexure P/6 dated 20.09.2019 and that in the circumstances the petitioners would be satisfied if the writ petition is disposed of at this stage by directing respondent No.3 to consider and

decide the claim as made in legal notice Annexure P/6 dated 20.09.2019 in accordance with law in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion to respondent Nos.1 to 3 only. Mr. Harish Rathee, Sr. DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 and states that the claim of the petitioners is highly belated as reliance is based on instructions dated 01.10.2003, whereas the writ petition is being filed in the year 2019.

4. Without commenting on the merits of the claim or entitlement of the petitioners to the relief claimed, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide the claim as made in legal notice Annexure P/6 dated 20.09.2019, after taking into account all aspects of the matter, within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
