Petitioner prays for grant of regular bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No.175 dated 23.04.2019 registered under Section 20 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station Rajendra Park, District Gurugram.

As per case of the prosecution, the petitioner alongwith other accused persons were travelling in a motor car being driven by Hari Om and co-accused. They were found in conscious possession of 50 Kg 100 gms *ganja* leaves which falls in the commercial category.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Devender Kumar, has submitted that the prosecution has already recorded deposition of 6 witnesses out of total 12 proposed to be examined.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the trial of the case is

already at an advanced stage. Hence, rather than considering the prayer for grant of bail, it is considered appropriate to direct the learned trial Court to conclude the criminal trial within a period of 4 months.

The Commissioner of Police, Gurugram is requested to ensure the presence of the prosecution witnesses who are stated to be the Police officials on the date fixed or to be fixed by the Court.

Disposed of, accordingly.
