The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.208 dated 4.5.2018 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 376/506 of Indian Penal Code (for short, 'IPC') at Police Station Baldev Nagar, District Ambala.

Heard.

A bare perusal of the FIR reveals that there are allegations that the petitioner forcibly made physical relations without the consent of the prosecutrix.

Learned counsel for the petitioner vehemently contended that the prosecutrix made material improvements in her deposition but this is no ground to grant bail as the trial Court critically examined the evidence.

Apart from this, the trial is in progress. Statements of nine witnesses have

been recorded.

No case for grant of bail is made out.

Dismissed.
