Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of bail pending trial to the petitioner in case FIR No.371 dated 01.07.2018, registered under Sections 148, 149, 307, 323 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Safidon, District Jind.

It is contended by learned Counsel for the petitioner that since 09.07.2018, petitioner is in custody and there is cross-version also. Further contended that from both sides i.e. petitioner as well as complainant, all have been released on bail except the petitioner. Also contended that since investigation is over and now the case is fixed for prosecution evidence, which will take a long time for its conclusion, thus, the petitioner deserves the concession of bail.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Naresh Kumar, has opposed the bail application primarily on the ground that

petitioner has caused the gun shot injury on the thigh of the complainant and that is duly established from the medical record.

After arguing for sometime, learned Counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition at this stage.

Permitted to do so.

Ordered accordingly.
