The present contempt petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of the order dated 1.8.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No. 18832 of 2018. The operative part of the order is reproduced below:

“In view of the above, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2-District Magistrate-cum-Deputy Commissioner, Ambala to consider and decide the representation dated 13.6.2018 (Annexure P-3) within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. In case, on consideration, respondent No. 2 reaches to the conclusion that the request of the petitioner is admissible, in such eventuality, the Arms Licence be issued to him as per provisions of the Arms Act, within a

period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority/respondent No. 2 feels that the request made by the petitioner is not admissible, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.”

The respondent has filed reply in court today, the same is taken on record. Copy is supplied to the counsel for the petitioner.

It has been submitted that in compliance of the order of this court, order has been passed. The same is annexed as Annexure-R-1.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that no cause of action survives in view of the reply of the respondent. However, he states that in case of any grievance, the petitioner will avail the remedies as are available in accordance with law.

The contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.
