[1] Challenge in the revision petition is to Order (Annexure P-1) dated 05.05.2018, whereby application of the contesting respondent-defendant for amendment of counter claim and impleadment of parties was allowed by the learned trial Court.

[2] Learned counsel appearing on behalf of contesting respondent-defendant No.1 states that respondent-defendant No.1 had withdrawn the application moved by her for amendment of counter claim and for impleadment of parties. In the circumstances, learned counsel for respondent-defendant No.1 submits that he has no objection, if the revision petition is allowed in terms thereof.
