Petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.0061 dated 29.07.2017 under Section 379 B IPC, registered at Police Station S.G.N. Dev Thermal Plant, District Bathinda (Annexure P-1) on the basis of compromise along with all consequential proceedings.

Allegations against the petitioners are of snatching of mobile.

The State in the reply has taken a stand that this compromise cannot be permitted as the trial is mature and fixed for defence evidence. In view of the law laid down by the Supreme Court in the case of “*Narinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another (2014)6 SCC 466*”, the compromise cannot be allowed at this stage.

Considering that the case is mature and entire evidence has been recorded and particularly, considering that case is of snatching of mobile,

there is no ground to allow the compromise at this stage.

Accordingly, petitionis dismissed.
