In view of the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed and amended/correct memo of parties is taken on record.

CRM-M-14093-2018 (O&M)

By way of filing this petition, the petitioners seek quashing of cross version recorded vide DDR No.20 dated 29.9.2012 recorded in FIR No.141 dated 1.10.2012 registered at Police Station Goraya, District Jalandhar under Sections 323 and 324 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and all consequential proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 6.4.2018, the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Phillaur has been received, wherein it has been reported that statements of petitioners/accused Amrik Singh, Harjinder Singh, Tajinder Singh and Lakhvir Singh @ Jajji and also of complainant Gurjit Singh have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves with the intervention of respectables and they have no objection in case the FIR is quashed.

The learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Phillaur has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (CrL.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and cross version recorded vide DDR No.20 dated 29.9.2012 recorded in FIR No.141 dated 1.10.2012 registered at Police Station Goraya, District Jalandhar under Sections 323 and 324 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
