The instant writ petition was filed seeking directions to the Punjab School Education Board to allot registration numbers to the petitioners so as to facilitate their participating in the 12th Class examination.

On a previous date of hearing i.e. on 28.11.2018, counsel had sought time to complete instructions on the aspect as regards the petitioners possessing requisite/recognised 10th Class qualification so as to be admitted in the 11th Class with the respondent No.4/School in the year 2017.
