Prayer in the writ petition is for the issuance of a writ of Mandamus for directing the respondents to release the death-cum-retiral benefits of deceased Karambir Singh, Peon, who died on 14.08.2018 while in service.

2. Learned counsel states that the petitioner has served legal notice Annexure P-2 dated 22.05.2019 in respect of the grievance which is the subject matter of the writ petition but the claim made in the legal notice has not been decided till date and that in the circumstances, the petitioner would be satisfied, if the writ petition is disposed of, at this stage, by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the claim made in the legal notice Annexure P-2 dated 22.05.2019 in accordance with law in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Harish Rathee, Sr. DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and states that he has no objection to the limited prayer of the petitioner.

5. Without commenting on the merits of the claim or the entitlement of the petitioners to the relief claimed, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the claim made in the legal notice Annexure P-2 dated 22.05.2019 in accordance with law after taking into account all aspects of the matter within eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
