This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 670 dated 7.10.2018 registered under Sections 336, 420, 34 IPC 1860, Sections 18A, 18C of Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940 and Sections 15 (2), 15 (3) Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 at PS Mujjesar, District Faridabad, Haryana.

On 5.12.2018 the following order was passed :-

“Through this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 670 dated 07.10.2018, registered under Sections 336 and 420 read with Section 34 IPC, Sections 18A and 18C of the Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940 and Sections 15(2) and 15(3) of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 at Police Station Mujjesar, District Faridabad, Haryana.

Adjourned to 14.02.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the

investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, he shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

Today counsel for the petitioner has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned AAG on instructions from SI Satpal Singh has accepted these factual assertions and stated that he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, keeping in view the entire conspectus of facts, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Petition is allowed. Interim order dated 5.12.2018 is made absolute.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
