ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in DDR No.37, dated 03.07.2018, under Sections 323, 324, 452, 427, 506, 148, 149 IPC and offence under Sections 325, 326 Cr.P.C. (P-2) added later on arising out of FIR No.58, dated 03.07.2018, Police Station Bhindi Saidan, District Amritsar (P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the FIR is the outcome of sudden quarrel between the parties in which injuries were received by both the sides.

A co-ordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 18.12.2018, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were to be

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released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sukhdev Singh, states that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners and keeping in view the fact that the petitioners have joined investigation, the order dated 18.12.2018 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
