It appears from the record that the application for examining Handwriting and Fingerprint Expert for the purpose of comparison of disputed signatures of defendant on the alleged agreement to sell dated 22.05.2017 with standard signatures of the defendant on Power of Attorney, written statement, affidavit and reply of stay application has been declined with a liberty to the defendant-petitioner to move an appropriate application at the relevant stage of his leading evidence.

As on date, plaintiff has not concluded his evidence and the defendant has not yet started his evidence.

In my considered opinion, liberty granted to the defendant-petitioner is just and appropriate.

Petitioner would be at liberty to lead his evidence at an appropriate stage.

No ground is made out to interfere in this revision petition.

This revision petition is accordingly, dismissed.
