By this petition, filed under the provisions of Section 439 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks the concession of 'regular bail'.

Learned counsel for the petitioner points to the order passed by this court (this Bench), on 02.12.2019 in CRM-M-36627 of 2019, in the case of Bhavkandan Singh, wherein he was ordered to be admitted to bail on account of the fact that he had remained in custody for the past 8 months, with only 1 prosecution witness out of 13 having been examined, with no other case shown to be registered against him.

Learned State counsel very fairly does not deny (on instructions) that as regards the parity of situation, the petitioners' case is no different from Bhavkandan Singh.

That being so, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, for or against the petitioner, this petition is allowed. The

petitioner would be enlarged on bail, upon his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
