GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

The present petition has been filed by the petitioner-Mukhand Khan *inter alia* praying for grant of interim bail for two weeks to the petitioner to attend his daughter's marriage, in case FIR No.160 dated 04.08.2019, under Section 15 of NDPS Act, 1985 (Section 29 of NDPS Act, 1985 added later on), registered at Police Station Gobindgarh Mandi, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

Notice of motion was issued by this Court on 16.12.2019, by passing the following order:-

“Prayer in this petition is for grant of interim bail to the petitioner for a period of 02 weeks in FIR No.160 dated 04.08.2019 registered under Section 15 of the NDPS Act (Section 29 of the NDPS Act added later) at Police Station Gobindgarh Mandi, District Fatehgarh

Sahib, to attend the marriage ceremony of his daughter.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Jagmohan Ghumman, DAG, Punjab who is present in the Court accepts notice on behalf of the respondent.

Counsel for the petitioner is directed to supply a complete copy of the paperbook to counsel for the State during the course of the day.

List again on 24.12.2019.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that marriage of the daughter of the petitioner is fixed for 01.01.2020.

Ms. Anju Sharma Kaushik, DAG, Punjab, appears on behalf of the State and makes a statement that in fact, the petitioner is also involved in an another FIR No.104 dated 06.08.2019.

Learned counsel for the parties submits that in fact, in the above said FIR No.104 dated 06.08.2019, the petitioner has already been granted interim bail on 06.12.2019 (Annexure P-9).

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is granted interim bail for two weeks, subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
