This present petition is of petitioner-Vikramjeet Singh seeking anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in a case bearing FIR No.0246 dated 05.10.2018 under Sections 498-A/377/506 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 66 (E) of the Information Technology Act, 2000 registered at Police Station Raman, District Bathinda.

The learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Makhan Singh, Police Station Raman, District Bathinda, states that petitioner has joined the investigations together with the contention of counsel for the

petitioner which could not be displaced by counsel for the complainant that the parties have effected a settlement/compromise before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, copy of which has been placed on the record.

In view of this, in the event of arrest, petitioner is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). He shall continue to join investigation and shall furnish an undertaking that he shall abide by the conditions specified under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. Thereafter, the petitioner will be permitted to furnish bail bonds to the satisfaction of the learned Trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
