The petitioner has approached this Court under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with the Punjab Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1998, for extension in the parole of the petitioner for four weeks from 18.12.2019 to 15.01.2020 as surgery of his wife Chander Kanta could not be done and is suffering from Cancer of Ovary third stage and has to undergo surgery, in case FIR No.99 dated 14.07.2016, registered under Sections 21(b), 21(c), 22(a), 22(c) and 29 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station Ismailabad, District Kurukshetra.

Learned counsel for the State has filed reply in the Court today, which is taken on record.

It is contended that earlier the petitioner was allowed parole vide order dated 11.07.2019 (Annexure P-1), whereby the facts of the petitioner being a cancer patient has been reflected.

Heard.

The petitioner did not misuse the concession of parole

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earlier. Keeping in view the above facts, the present petition is allowed and the parole of the petitioner is further extended for a period of four weeks on his furnishing indemnity bond in the sum of ₹1,00,000/- with two local sureties in the like amount to the satisfaction of the District Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned. The petitioner shall surrender before the jail authorities after expiry of four weeks and date and time of surrender to be noticed by the releasing Court.
