Petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for dismissal of complaint No.11503/2016 (Annexure P-1) and summoning order dated 03.11.2016 (Annexure P-2) as well as for setting aside the order of revisional Court dated 17.1.2018 (Annexure P-3) vide which revision petition against the summoning order was dismissed.

Learned counsel for the respondent/complainant fairly states that the case of the petitioner is at par with co-accused Vikas Jain and the impugned complaint already stands quashed in respect of Vikas Jain vide judgment dated 25.7.2019 passed by this Court in CRM-M-12296 of 2018. He further states that the other two connected criminal complaints qua

petitioner Dharam Dev Goyal and co-accused Vikas Jain have also been quashed through the said judgment dated 25.7.2019.

Since the case is covered by the judgment passed in CRM-M-12296-2018 by this Court vide order dated 25.7.2019, resultantly, the present petition is allowed and the impugned complaint No.11503/2016 (Annexure P-1) and summoning order dated 03.11.2016 (Annexure P-2) are hereby quashed qua petitioner.
