Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No. 92, dated 14.08.2018, under Sections 160, 148 and 149 of the IPC (Section 307 IPC added later on) and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Talwandi Choudhrian, District Kapurthala.

The operative part of the order dated 19.12.2018, vide which the petitioners have been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that as per the allegations in the FIR, complainant ASI Paramjit Singh received a secret information that a group of 28-30 persons, armed with Datars and Kirpans, some of whom were named in the FIR, are quarreling with another group of 10-12 young persons. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners were not named in the FIR and four persons were apprehended at the spot and they have been granted concession of regular bail. Learned counsel for the

petitioners relies upon order dated 03.12.2018, vide which, some of the co-accused have been granted concession of anticipatory bail in CRM-M Nos. 41507, 46987, 47883 and 49745 of 2018.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioners, in pursuance to the order dated 19.12.2018, have already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and have joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Darshan Lal, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners, vide order dated 19.12.2018, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
