Petitioners are presently serving on the post of Junior Engineer and Fieldman respectively under the Punjab State Power Corporation Limited.

Prayer in the instant writ petition is for grant of 23 years advance promotional increments.

It is the contention raised by counsel that the claim of the petitioners would be covered in terms of judgment dated 29.11.2018 passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court in **CWP-1013-2017 (Balvir Singh Vs. PSPCL & another)** and other connected petitions.

Counsel submits that even a notice dated 05.02.2018 (Annexure P-3) has been served upon the respondent/Corporation and he would be satisfied if the instant writ petition was to be disposed of with a direction to respondent/authorities to examine the claim of the petitioners and to take a decision within a stipulated time frame.

Prayer made by counsel is found to be just and reasonable.

Without even examining the claim of the petitioners on merits, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant writ petition with a direction to respondent No.1/competent authority to examine the claim of the petitioners and to take a final decision on the notice dated 05.02.2018 (Annexure P-3) in accordance with law and to pass a final order within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
