The petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.98 dated 22.6.2018, registered at Police Station Radaur, District Yamuna Nagar, under Sections 379-B, 427, 506 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in custody for more than 05 months and there is no criminal case pending against him. The trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date as only 02 PWs have been examined out of 13 PWs and therefore, he may be released on regular bail.

Custody certificate dated 7.1.2019, prepared by Sh. Rajender Singh, Deputy Superintendent, District Prison, Yamuna Nagar, has been filed by the learned State counsel in Court today and the same is taken on record. According to this certificate, the petitioner has undergone actual custody of 05 months and 24 days and there is no criminal case pending against him.

It is thus, apparent that the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date and there is no criminal case pending against the petitioner.

Thus, keeping in view the custody period undergone by the petitioner, it would be in the interest of justice to release the petitioner on bail.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed and petitioner-Mukesh Kumar, is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned.
