1. The petitioners seek grant of anticipatory bail in respect of FIR No.75 dated 23.04.2018 under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code, Police Station Kartarpur, Jalandhar.
2. The allegations pertain to an agreement for sale of land. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that in fact the parties have entered into a compromise and a petition i.e. CRM-M-41231-2018 has already been filed for quashing of FIR in question on grounds of compromise, which is pending for 29.7.2019.
3. The aforestated submission regarding filing of petition for quashing of FIR on grounds of compromise is not disputed by learned State counsel.

4. In view of the aforestated position and while also bearing in mind that the petitioners have already joined investigation, the petition is accepted and the interim directions issued vide dated 18.12.2018 by this Court are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioners would appear before Investigating Officer as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
