Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.187 dated 13.10.2019, under Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914 registered at Police Station Dhanaula, District Barnala.

As per the prosecution case, the alleged recovery was effected from the residence of the petitioner, who managed to escape.

During the course of the hearing, it is not disputed by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner already stands convicted in two criminal cases bearing FIR No.18 dated 14.07.2016, under Section 15/61/85 of NDPS Act, Police Station, GRP Sirhind, District Fatehgarh Sahib and FIR No.3 dated 12.01.2018, under Section 61 of the Excise Act, Police Station Dhanaula, District Barnala.

Considering the above, this Court does not consider it to be a fit case for grant of extraordinary concession of pre-arrest bail.

Petition stands dismissed.
