[1] Prayer in the writ petition is for the issuance of a writ of mandamus for directing the respondents to remove the pay anomaly of Selection Grade of ₹7500 – 12000 w.e.f. 01.01.1996 instead of 01.08.2000 on the post of Lecturer in terms of Government of Haryana letter (Annexure P-1) dated 12.12.2000 vide which Head Masters of Government High School and 20% cadre posts of Lecturers in Government Senior Secondary Schools were granted the benefit of Selection Grade.

[2] Learned counsel contends that the petitioner has submitted legal notice (Annexure P-5) dated 07.11.2019 but the claim in respect thereto has not been decided, till date and that in the circumstances, the petitioner would be satisfied, if the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the claim made in the legal notice (Annexure P-5) dated 07.11.2019, in accordance with law in a time bound manner.

[3] Notice of motion.

[4] Mr. Harish Rathee, learned Senior Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and states that he has no objection to the limited prayer of the petitioner.

[5] Without commenting upon the merits of the claim or the entitlement of the petitioner to the relief claimed, the writ petition is ***disposed of*** by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the claim made in the legal notice (Annexure P-5) dated 07.11.2019, in accordance with law, after taking into account all aspects of the matter within a period of 03 months from the date of certified copy of this order.
