Petitioner Jagdish Chander has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.499 dated 22.09.2018, registered at Police Station Pundri, District Kaithal, under Sections 323, 324, 326, 506 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned State counsel has appeared on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the present petitioner has been named in the FIR. He is stated to be armed with lathi and simple injuries have been attributed to him. Grievous injuries have been attributed to the

co-accused.

The petitioner has already joined the investigation as submitted by learned State counsel. He is not required for custodial interrogation. No useful purpose would be served by sending him to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. In the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
