1. None has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner. Even on the last date of hearing, there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner.
2. In the present case, notice of motion had been issued to the limited extend for examining propriety of sentence.
3. The petitioner stands convicted for offence punishable under Section 356 IPC and has been sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for a period of one year.

4. As per the custody certificate filed today by learned State counsel, the petitioner has already undergone the sentence of 1 year, which includes remissions to the tune of 2 months & 12 days.
