[1] Prayer in the writ petition is for the issuance of a writ of certiorari for quashing transfer list (Annexure P-9) *qua* the petitioner, whereby the respondents have directed the petitioner to be relieved from the post of Mali in the Department of Division Forest Office and to join the post of Helper in Irrigation and Water Resources Department. Prayer is also for the issuance of a writ of mandamus to direct the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner for appointment to the post of Group 'D' against BCA Category and to allocate the post of Animal Attendant to the petitioner as per the merit of the petitioner in BCA Category.

[2] Learned counsel states that the petitioner has submitted representation (Annexure P-11) dated 11.12.2019 in respect of the grievance, which is the subject matter of the instant writ petition, but the same has not been decided and that in the circumstances, the petitioner would be satisfied, if the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.1 to consider and

decide the representation (Annexure P-11) dated 11.12.2019, in accordance with law, in a time bound manner.

[3] Without commenting upon the merits of the claim or the entitlement of the petitioner to the relief claimed, the writ petition is ***disposed of*** by directing respondent No.1 to consider and decide the representation (Annexure P-11) dated 11.12.2019, in accordance with law, after taking into account all aspects of the matter within a period of 06 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
