The petitioner CWP No. 2285 of 2019. The same was disposed of on 28.1.2019. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“Without going into the merits of the case or expressing any opinion to the entitlement of the petitioner in respect of the claim prayed in the present writ petition or in the representation, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to pass an appropriate speaking order on the claim raised by the petitioner in the representation dated 19.12.2018 (Annexure P-3) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case after the order, it is found by the respondents that the petitioner is entitled for any monetary benefits, the same should also be released to him within a period of next three months.

The writ petition stands disposed of.”

Thereafter COCP No. 1925 of 2019 was filed pleading that

needful has not been done. On 6.9.2019, learned counsel for the petitioner stated that retiral benefits have been released but the claim with regard to interest on delayed payment has not been considered. The contempt petition was disposed of directing the respondents that claim with regard to interest be considered within eight weeks.

The present petition is filed pleading wilful disobedience of the directions of this Court in the contempt petition.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Aditya Sharda, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. He produces order dated 13.11.2019 whereby the claim with regard to interest has been rejected.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law against the said order.

Disposed of with liberty as prayed for.
