This Court, on the previous date of hearing i.e. 30.04.2019,
passed the following order:-

“ Present petition has been filed for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 and 2 to transfer the investigation in case FIR No. 187 dated 23.10.2018, under Section 302 and 201/34 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station B Division, Amritsar, District Amritsar to some senior Police Officer not below the rank of IPS Officer.

On 01.03.2019, this Court has passed the following order:

'Present petition has been filed for issuance of direction to respondents no.1 and 2 to transfer the investigation in case FIR No.187 dated 23.10.2018, under Sections 302 and 201/34 IPC, registered at Police Station B Division, Amritsar, District Amritsar to some senior Police Officer not below the rank of IPS Officer.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Manjinder Singh, has apprised the Court that after investigation report under Section 173 Cr.P.C has already been submitted against three accused namely Gurpreet Singh, Narinder Singh and Harpreet Singh and so far as the 4th accused is concerned, police is making every possible effort for his arrest and needful will be done shortly.

In view of the above, adjourned to 30.04.2019.'

Today, learned State counsel on instructions from HC Updesh Singh has apprised the Court that 4th co-accused, namely, Navdeep Singh has also been arrested on 14.03.2019 and report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. qua him shall be submitted within a period of two weeks from today.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioners.

In the interest of justice, adjourned to 21.05.2019.

At the outset, learned Counsel for the petitioners in view of the stand taken by the State wishes to withdraw the present petition.
