The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail because non-bailable warrants of arrest have been issued against him by the trial Court where a complaint under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881, is pending against him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was present on all dates but on one particular date i.e. 15.10.2019, he failed to put in appearance due to illness. The petitioner undertakes never to absent himself again during the trial.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition can be disposed of without issuing notice of motion to the respondents.

The petition is accordingly disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court on or before the next date of hearing and seek regular bail. In case, such an application is filed, the trial Court is directed to allow the same.
