The present criminal writ petition has been filed by the petitioners under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to provide protection to the life and liberty of the petitioners who are apprehending imminent danger at the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 7.

Upon notice, reply has been filed by the State of Haryana by way of an affidavit of Mr.Suresh Kumar, HPS Additional Superintendent of Police, Sirsa.

It has been so submitted in the reply, and is also argued by the learned State counsel that the petitioners had made a representation to the police at Sirsa. Pursuant thereto, the petitioners as well as respondents Nos.4 to 7 were called by the police. However, the petitioners refused to come to the police. On the other hand, respondent Nos.4 to 7 got recorded their statements that they will not harass and issue any threat to the petitioners in future or cause any infringement to the lives and liberty of the petitioners. They do not have any objection to the alleged second marriage of petitioner No.1 to petitioner No.2.

In view of the above, the present petition does not survive.

Dismissed, as such.
