Prayer in the petition is to grant regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.175 dated 09.06.2017 registered under Sections 307, 34, 216 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act at Police Station Nangal Chaudhary, District Mahendergarh.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that fire shot injury is not attributed to the petitioner and he is in custody for the last more than 7 months since he was arrested on 22.10.2018. He has further submitted that the investigation is complete. Challan has been presented and the complainant is not coming forward to depose in the Court. He has further submitted that the complainant-injured was summoned by non-bailable warrants for 23.05.2019. However, since Presiding Judge was on leave, therefore, the case has now been adjourned to 09.07.2019.

Keeping in view the contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner and period of custody of the petitioner and without commenting on the merits of the case, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
