FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

This order shall dispose off first anticipatory bail application filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. by petitioners Bijender and Babli Devi in case bearing FIR No.607 dated 23.11.2018 registered at Police Station Ganaur, District Sonipat under Sections 323, 354-B, 506, 34 IPC and Section 8 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI (Ms.) Seema, Police Station Ganaur, District Sonipat submits that in compliance of the orders of interim bail dated 17.12.2018 passed by this Court, both the petitioners have joined investigations and that they are no longer required for further investigation and nothing is to be recovered from them and she has no objection if the interim order is made absolute.

In view of the stand of the State and in the light of orders passed earlier, the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated

17.12.2018 is made absolute on the same terms and conditions till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, they will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
