The petitioners have preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.79 dated 26.08.2018, registered under Section(s) 304-B, 34 IPC, at Police Station, Ghuman, District Batala.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Daljit Singh, has stated that the petitioners have joined the investigation; nothing is to be recovered from them and they are no more required for custodial interrogation.

Learned counsel for the complainant has also submitted that the complainant has no objection if the petitioners be given the benefit of anticipatory bail.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case,

I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to

the petitioners in the present case.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 17.12.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
