Prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing of FIR No. 89 dated 2.5.2013, under Sections 420, 406, 467, 468, 471 and 120B IPC, registered at Police Station City Jagraon, District Ludhiana, and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 1.12.2018 (Annexure P-2), arrived at between the parties.

Order dated 26.2.2019, qua deposit of costs has been complied with and photocopies of the receipts have been placed on record.

Vide letter No.74 dated 17.1.2019, report of the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Jagraon (Ludhiana), duly forwarded by the learned District & Sessions Judge, Ludhiana vide letter No. 76 dated 25.1.2019, has been received. As per report, compromise entered into between the parties, is appears to be genuine, voluntary and without any coercion and undue

influence.

Considering the report of the learned JMIC, Jagraon dated 17.1.2019 and the fact that the compromise will bring peace and harmony in relations between the parties, aforesaid FIR No. 89 dated 2.5.2013, and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are quashed qua petitioner only.

Disposed of accordingly.
