The prayer of the petitioner is to direct the National Insurance Company Limited to release compensation to the tune of ₹15 Lakhs in relation to the death of his brother, Deep Kumar, the registered owner of a motorcycle which was covered by an insurance policy issued by the National Insurance Company Limited.

This Court is of the opinion that the factual issues which would arise for determination in a matter of this nature cannot be resolved in a writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution. It is for the petitioner to go before the appropriate forum which can undertake such an exercise and seek relief.

The writ petition is accordingly dismissed leaving it open to the

petitioner to do so in accordance with law.
