Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondent Nos. 2 & 3 for protection of life and liberty and joint properties of petitioner No.1, who is traumatized by her own son and daughter-in-law, respondents No.4 and 5.

Reply filed by the State, is already on record. It has been pointed out in the reply that at the instance of respondent No.4 the FIR has already been registered against the petitioners No.1 and 3

Otherwise also, the claim of the petitioners, on the face of it, is civil in nature.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.

However, the petitioners should be at liberty to avail their remedies before the Civil Court qua their grievance raised in the petition and to avail other remedies, in accordance with law, qua the FIR lodged against them.
