GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J.(Oral)

By way of filing this petition, the petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.187 dated 11.9.2017 registered at Police Station Ghall Khurd, District Ferozepur under Sections 307, 324, 323, 341, 427, 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 25/27 of Arms Act and all consequential proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 15.12.2018, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Ferozepur has been received, wherein it has been reported that statements of petitioners/accused Sukhchain Singh, Sohan Singh, Nirmal Singh, Gurpreet Singh and Lovepreet Singh and also of complainant Gurtej Singh have been

recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves and they have no objection in case the FIR is quashed. Other than the complainant Gurtej Singh, there are two other persons namely Sukhjit Singh and Kikkar Singh, who are stated to be aggrieved persons. Statements of said Sukhjit Singh and Kikkar Singh have also been recorded by the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Ferozepur, who have also expressed that they have no objection in case the FIR is quashed.

The learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Ferozepur has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (CrL.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.187 dated 11.9.2017 registered at Police Station Ghall Khurd, District Ferozepur under Sections 307, 324, 323, 341, 427, 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 25/27 of Arms Act and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
