1. Prayer in the writ petition is for the issuance of a writ of Mandamus for directing the respondents to grant minimum regular pay scale meant for the post of Patwari along with arrears etc.

2. Learned counsel contends that vide order Annexure P/6 dated 22.07.2019, CWP No.19763 of 2019, was disposed of by this Court by directing the respondents to consider the claim of similarly situated co-employees and that pursuant thereto, relief as claimed by the petitioners therein, was granted to the similarly situated co-employees.

3. Learned counsel contends that the petitioners have submitted representation Annexure P/3 dated 20.06.2019, in respect of the grievance which is the subject matter of the instant writ petition but the same has not been decided till date and that in the circumstances the petitioners would be satisfied if the writ petition is disposed of at

this stage by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the

claim as made in representation Annexure P/3 dated 20.06.2019 in accordance with law by taking into account the decision of this Court in CWP No.19763 of 2019, in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion. Mr. Harish Rathee, Sr. DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and states that he has no objection to the innocuous prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners.

4. Without commenting on the merits of the claim or entitlement of the petitioners to the relief claimed, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the claim as made in representation Annexure P/3 dated 20.06.2019, after taking into account all aspects of the matter including the decision of this Court in CWP No.17963 of 2019, in case the same is applicable to the facts and circumstances of the case, within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
