The present petition has been filed with the following substantive prayers:-

“It is therefore most respectfully prayed that the present petition may kindly be allowed and the respondent no.2 for taking appropriate action and to transfer the investigation in respect to FIR No.0444 dated 02.11.2017 U/s 346 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station, Kurukshetra, District Kurukshetra (Annexure P-1) to the Crime Branch of the State or to an Independent Agency, or to the higher rank police officer, as the during the investigation the local police are favouring the accused and further direction to by arresting the named accused in the FIR, submit the investigation report and prosecute the accused persons in accordance with law in the present case, in the interest of justice.”

Pursuant to the notice, reply by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra, has been filed giving details of various steps having been taken in this regard. It has been pointed out that one accused has already been arrested but released on bail.

Investigations against two accused i.e. Gurnam and Manoj

Kumar are complete and they have been found innocent, whereas remaining two accused have already been declared proclaimed offenders.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the investigating officer has not taken steps to attach the bank account in which the amount was transferred.

Learned counsel for the State, on the instructions from SI Subhash Chander, has submitted that the investigating officer would verify this fact and if amount is passed in the aforesaid account, the same shall be adjusted within a period of 10 days.

Hence, the petition stands disposed of.
