Prayer made in the petition is for issuing directions to the trial Court to conclude the trial arising out of complaint No. 787 dated 30.7.2014 under Sections 452, 326, 323, 324, 34 registered at Police Station Ghuman, District Gurdaspur in a time bound manner.

The trial Court was directed to submit a report about the disposal of the case and as per the report dated 16.3.2019, after all the summoned accused appeared before the Court, the case was fixed for pre-charge evidence of the complainant, who has examined two witnesses and has given up two other witnesses, thereafter the complainant moved an application for summoning Medical Officer and record-keeper, alongwith MLR of the complainant and the case is now fixed for recording the pre-charge evidence of the complainant.

In view of the same, I find that the delay in disposal of the trial is not attributed to the complainant as the accused persons furnished their bail bonds only on 4.10.2018, no further action is required.
