Prayer in the petition is to release the petitioner on regular bail in FIR No.75 dated 23.03.2018 registered under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station Raman District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the State has informed the Court that out of ten witnesses, three witnesses have been examined and recovery from the petitioner is in the category of commercial. He also submits that the next date fixed before the learned trial court is 08.05.2019. Learned State counsel has also assured that all sincere efforts will be made positively to produce the witnesses.

Keeping in view the fact that the trial is at the advanced stage, it is considered appropriate to request the learned trial court to conclude the trial within two months.
