Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.11 dated 14.10.2018 under Sections 406/498-A/506 IPC registered at Women Police Station, Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to order dated 07.01.2019 of this Court, the parties have appeared before the mediator and the matter has been settled. A settlement/compromise deed dated 10.04.2019 has been reduced into writing.

Report of the mediator has also been received along with the compromise deed dated 10.04.2019, which shows that the parties have settled the matter amicably.

In view of above, since the matter has been compromised between the parties, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent-State that in case the petitioner is required in the aforesaid FIR, a 7 days prior notice be given to him.
