Prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing of FIR No. 58 dated 18.6.2018, under Sections 323, 325 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Khanori, Tehsil Moonak, District Sangrur, and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated nil (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

Order dated 6.3.2019, qua deposit of costs has been complied with and photocopy of the receipt has been placed on record.

Vide letter No.42 dated 30.1.2019, report of the Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Moonak (Sangrur), has been received. As per report, a compromise entered into between the parties, is appears to be genuine, voluntary and without any coercion and undue influence.
